Did You Know That...?

Around 10% of the world's population, or 650 million people, live with a disability. They are the world's largest minority.

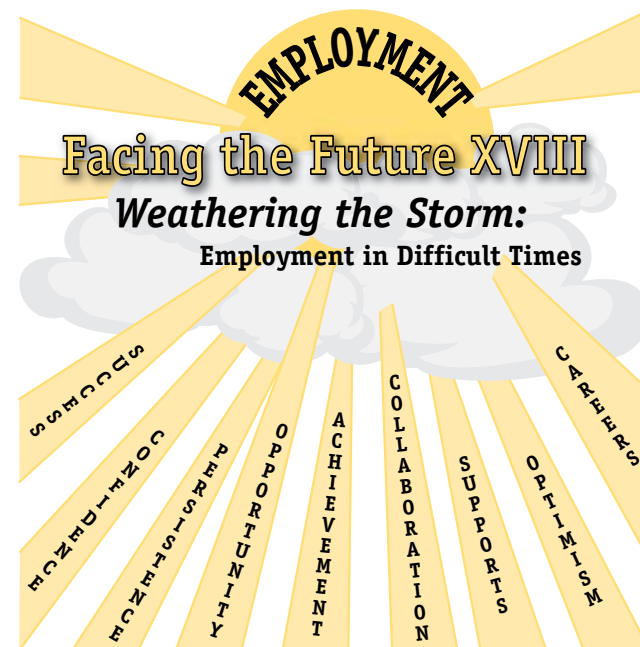
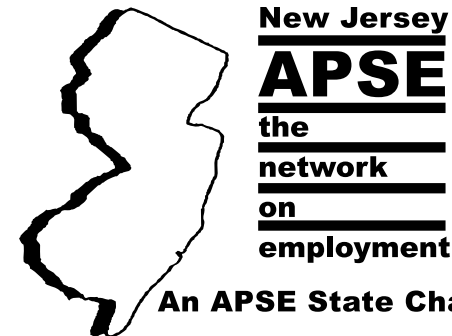
A 2007 United States survey found that only 37% of working-age people with disabilities are in fact working compared to 80% of those without disabilities.

Two-thirds of those who are unemployed and with a disability said they would like to work but could not find jobs.

In 2007, there were more than 4300 people with disabilities who became successfully employed in New Jersey as a result of services provided by Supported Employment vendors in New Jersey.

A University of Massachusetts & Harris Poll study found that 93% of customers surveyed said they would PREFER to patronize a business that has people with disabilities in their workforce.

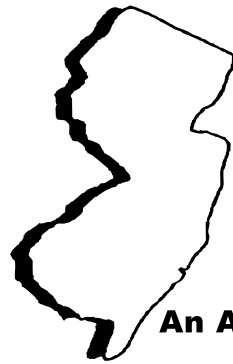
